WHAT IS THIS PROJECT ABOUT?

#ExchangeForEquality is an international youth encounter between young people from Berlin/Germany and Nairobi/Kenya.

The focus of the project is on SDG5: achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls. Through joint online workshops and 16-day visits of Nairobi and Berlin respectively, the participants from Berlin and Nairobi together explore the realities of girls and women in both countries and will learn about the issues faced by girls and women today - in politics, in the home and in education, for example.

By way of creating digital stories about their encounters, the participants share their experiences on SDG5 as part of the UN 16 Days of Action Against Gender-Based Violence Campaign 2022, to let the world know that girls' and women's issues worldwide matter!

The project provides an opportunity for vibrant young people from both countries to take active part in furthering the achievement of SDG5 milestones as part of the 2030 Development Agenda.

WHEN?

WHERE?

WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

- We will go on a sightseeing tour through Nairobi, a nature excursion to Karura Forest and a visit to Maasai market.
- We will visit local NGOs to explore work on SDG5, for example "Boxgirls Kenya", who provide a safe space for girls and women to train sports and learn about female empowerment and social change.
- We will do street quiz interviews on SDG5 with the local community, for example at a church visit.
- We will visit family homes, share local meals together, and learn about family traditions.
- We will share our knowledge about SDG5 with the pupils at a local girls' school.
- We will meet with a Kenyan female politician to discuss women in politics and in the public sphere.
- We will, of course, also have some free time to enjoy Nairobi and Kenyan culture!
